## Swim Lessons

Saturdays - 6 weeks starting September 24th *Residents: \$20 - Non Residents: \$30*

*\*6 students per class\**

9:00 am -9:30 am: Levels 1 & 2

9:40 am -10:10 am: Level 3 & 4

10:20 am - 10:50 am: Level 5 & 6

*Level 1 Water Exploration: This level is to help students feel comfortable in the water. Swimmers will learn how to submerge their heads, basic breath control, and supported floating on front/back.*

*Level 2 Primary Skills: Gives swimmers success with fundamental skills and learn to float without support.*

*Level 3 Stroke Readiness: Swimmers learn the fundamentals of front/back crawl, treading water and are introduced to the back stroke.*

*Level 4 Stroke Development: Swimmers develop confidence in strokes learned thus far and work to improve other aquatic skills. An introduction to the breaststroke, sidestroke and wall turns is provided.*

*Level 5 Stroke Refinement: Swimmers work on coordination and refinement of key strokes. Introduce the butterfly, open turns, feet-first service dives. Swimmers increase swim distances.*

*Level 6 Skill Proficiency: Swimmers polish strokes so they swim with more ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over great distances.*

## Youth Programs

### Creative Crafts for Kids
