UPDATED PRESS RELEASE

At approximately 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, November 11 2017, the Marysville Police and Fire Departments were dispatch to a reported shooting at the Jump n Jam, 3198 Gratiot in Marysville. Investigation has identified, Matthew Pilarowski of Kimball Township entered his wife's business and shot her. Cheryl Myny was transported to Lake Huron Medical Center by Marysville Fire Paramedics where she died a short time later.

Matthew Pilarowski was found deceased by what is believed to be a self-inflicted gunshot in their residence later that evening.

At this point in the investigation it appears this was a result of domestic violence.

Patrons of the business that had personal property left that evening should contact the Marysville Police Department, (810) 364-6300, to arrange return of their belongings.

More details are being gathered as the homicide is being investigated. Marysville Police and Fire were assisted by officers from Port Huron, City of St. Clair, St. Clair County Sheriff's Office, Michigan State Police, Michigan Department of Natural Resources, U.S. Border Patrol and Customs.
