

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Huron Boulevard Reconstruction

Connecticut Avenue to M-29

The reconstruction of Huron Boulevard from Connecticut Avenue to M-29 is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 4, 2018. The project will be completed half-width, with the eastbound lanes being reconstructed first, followed by the westbound lanes. Traffic will be maintained in one direction throughout the project, which will allow access to businesses and Marysville High School.

Schools are urged to notify their transportation department of the closures, as well as parents and students who typically use eastbound Huron Boulevard between Connecticut Avenue and Michigan Avenue. The closure west of Michigan Avenue will take effect prior to summer break.

Businesses are urged to notify their customers of the closures and provide directions on how to access the business if it is located within project limits. Area businesses that have trucks that typically use Huron Boulevard or Michigan Avenue should plan the most efficient detour routes and notify all carriers.

Residents and businesses within the work area will be provided access to their driveways throughout the project except for periods where concrete work will necessitate closure of the driveway for placing and curing of concrete. When necessary, efforts will be made to provide alternative parking locations. Anyone having physical disabilities within the work area should contact the Project Engineer to attempt to coordinate accommodations.

The project is being financed by city road funds, a state economic development grant and federal surface transportation funds and will result in Huron Boulevard being reduced from 4-lanes (two in each direction) to 3-lanes (one in each direction with a center left-turn lane). The change in configuration will improve the safety of the roadway, while maintaining the necessary capacity for the traffic volumes.

Tentative Road Closure Schedule

Reconstruction of eastbound lanes of Huron Boulevard

- June 4, 2018 - Eastbound Huron Boulevard closed between Connecticut Avenue and Michigan Avenue. One lane of westbound Huron Boulevard will remain open during construction. The signed detour for eastbound Huron will be southwest on Gratiot Boulevard, south on Range Road, east on Cuttle Road and north on M-29.
- June 14, 2018 – Eastbound Huron Boulevard closed from Connecticut Avenue to M-29. One lane of westbound Huron Boulevard will remain open during construction. Michigan Avenue will be closed at Huron Boulevard. Eastbound Huron detour is the same as above. The detour for southbound Michigan Avenue will follow the same detour. Northbound Michigan Avenue traffic may use westbound Huron Boulevard from M-29 to Michigan Avenue or M-29 to Gratiot Boulevard.

Reconstruction of westbound lanes of Huron Boulevard

- July 20, 2018 – Eastbound Huron Boulevard reopens with one lane maintained. Westbound Huron Boulevard closed between M-29 and Connecticut. Michigan Avenue will remain closed at Huron Boulevard. The signed detour for westbound Huron Boulevard will be south on M-29, west on Cuttle Road, north on Range Road and northeast on Gratiot Boulevard. Detours for Michigan Avenue will remain the same as in the eastbound reconstruction phase.
- August 24, 2018 – Roadway open to traffic in both directions.
