OPENING REMARKS:

1. City Manager Randall Fernandez gave opening remarks.
2. Intern Kurt Fitzgerald was introduced.

PRESENTATIONS:

1. Lauren Hoffman, Environmental Consulting & Technology, Inc., presented a conceptual drawing of the suggested Marysville City Park Improvements.
2. Bill Vogan, William Vogan Architects, presented a rendering of the proposed Municipal Campus.
3. Council Member Barber spoke on the need for a fishing pier and the possibility of moving the fishing pier from the DTE Site to the boat docking area if the fishing pier is gifted to the city.

TOPICS DISCUSSED:

1. The existing conditions of the park as well as the desired improvements were discussed including more parking, better circulation, connectivity and flow. Some of the other improvements include:
  - a. extended bike path
  - b. ADA accessible playground equipment
  - c. adult fitness area
  - d. 18 hole disc golf course
  - e. enhanced baseball fields
  - f. relocated sledding hill
  - g. proposed dog park
  - h. updated splash pad
2. The floor plan for the proposed Municipal Campus was discussed with an option for a larger practice room. The building will incorporate administration offices, the historical museum, meeting/community rooms and recreational programs under one roof. The matter will be brought before voters on November 3<sup>rd</sup> in the form of an advisory vote. Voters will be asked to approve going forward with the new building if it will not result in an increased millage rate or bond offering.
3. General discussion took place regarding the need for a fishing pier, adding the pier onto the end of the existing dock, the cost to relocate and refurbish the pier, and how much should be spent on the project.
