### Coronavirus Information and Municipal Building Closures

Effective Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> until further notice the City of Marysville will be closing its buildings to the public in an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19. This will be reviewed weekly. Updates will be posted to our website [cityofmarysvillemi.com](http://cityofmarysvillemi.com) and our Facebook page [City of Marysville, Michigan](https://www.facebook.com/CityofMarysvilleMichigan).

The following buildings will be affected:

- City Hall
- Marysville Community Center (Recreation)
- Department of Public Safety (Police, Fire & Ambulance Services)
- Department of Public Service (Public Works, Water & Wastewater)

Buildings will still be staffed. City hall's operating hours are 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The Department of Public Safety and Public Service are open from 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Essential services such as police, fire, ambulance, water, wastewater and trash removal/recycling are still available.

Payments and paperwork such as property transfers, job applications, etc. may be mailed or placed into our drop box outside city hall. Box will be checked several times daily.

Water main breaks, pot holes, missed trash, code violations or building permit information may be reported or obtained by calling our Department of Public Service at (810) 364-8340.

Police records may be obtained by calling (810) 364-6300. For other services please call the aforementioned number.

All programs coordinated by Marysville Recreation Department are cancelled.

#### **Tips for Residents:**

*First and foremost we ask that all residents REMAIN CALM during this unprecedented event. It is critical that we maintain order to ensure that our resources are used in the most effective way to prevent, prepare for and treat any cases of Coronavirus in our community.*

- Stay home when you are sick except to receive medical care.
- Cough or sneeze into your upper arm or cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue (and then through them into the trash).
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds (about the amount of time it takes to sing Happy Birthday). Use hand sanitizer when you can't use soap and water.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Clean frequently touched surfaces (door knobs, light switches, elevator buttons, toilets, faucets, etc.) as often as possible and at least daily.
- Practice social distancing public (leave a six foot space between you and another person).
