CONSENT AGENDA:

Moved by Council Member Badley, supported by Mayor Pro-Tem Hayman to approve the Consent Agenda.

- A. Approved City Council Minutes and Public Hearing Minutes of June 14, 2021 and minutes of the Committee of the Whole Workshop of June 21, 2021.
Motion passed unanimously.

ACTION AGENDA:

- A. Moved by Council Member Wessel, supported by Council Member Badley to approve bills in the amount of \$212,005.49, payroll for July 9, 2021 and electronic payments in the amount of \$171,136.95.
Motion passed unanimously.
- B. Moved by Mayor Pro-Tem Hayman, supported by Council Member Winston to approve payments to Shirkey Electric in the amount of \$2,571.50 for work at the DPW, Golf Course, Water Plant and Wastewater Plant. Yes: Mayor Pyden, Mayor Pro-Tem Hayman, Council Members Badley, Barber, Winston and Wessel. Abstained: Council Member Shirkey. Motion passed.
- C. Moved by Council Member Shirkey, supported by Council Member Badley to approve recommendation to accept the lowest cost responsive bid from Zimmer Roofing of Port Huron, MI with a base price of \$17,811.00 and approval to spend up to \$4,400.00 for wood replacement, with a total cost not to exceed \$22,211.00. Motion passed unanimously.

- B. Public Safety Chief Konik recapped on Mermaid Park.
