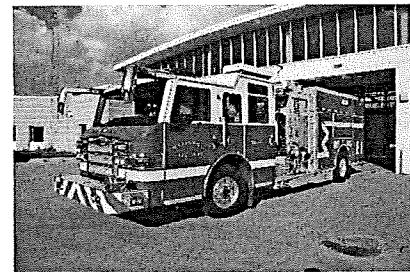




NOW HIRING FIRE FIGHTER / PARAMEDICS



The City of Marysville is accepting applications for the position of full-time Firefighter-Paramedic. Minimum application requirements include being a high school graduate, Michigan Firefighter I & II, Hazardous Materials Operations Level, and Michigan licensed paramedic. A valid Michigan Drivers License, acceptable driving record and clean criminal history are required for consideration. Preference will be given to applicants with a college degree, applicable experience as determined by the city, and military service. Prior to appointment, candidates must successful complete an interview, background investigation, physical and drug screen.



Positions are not grant funded. Starting wage is \$66,314 plus benefits including city retirement plan effective July 1, 2021.

The Marysville Fire Department is a combination department with 10 career, part-time and on-call staff providing fire suppression, advanced life support ambulance and all-hazards emergency service to the City of Marysville and portions of St. Clair Township. The department was established in 1919, and operates a fleet of three fire apparatus, two ambulances, fireboat and specialty support vehicles from one central station. In addition to 911-generated runs, the department also provides community education, tactical paramedics, code enforcement and fire investigations.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT APPLICANTS:

The City of Marysville has established minimum qualifications for entry level Fire applicants for the Marysville Fire Department. Applicants **MUST** have the following background at the time of submission of their Application for Employment and documentation (COPIES of the certificates) **MUST** accompany the application:

1. Michigan Fire Fighters Training Council Firefighter I & II Certificate
2. Hazardous Materials First Responder, Operations Level Certificate
3. Michigan Fire Fighters Training Council Drivers Training Certificate
4. Michigan Licensed Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic
5. American Heart Association, Advanced Cardiac Life Support Provider
6. NIMS-IC100, 200, 700 and 800 Certificates

In addition to the above stated requirements, applicants will be evaluated on the basis of the following:

- Driving record and background investigation
- Written Exam
- Oral Board
- Physical ability test
- A medical examination, respirator fit test and drug screening
- College Education
- Advanced fire, rescue or EMS training

Job Description – Firefighter/Paramedic

Respond to fire and medical emergencies performing required tasks while wearing full personal protective equipment including self-contained breathing apparatus. Perform physically demanding tasks during extreme fluctuations in temperature. Working in hazardous areas that are hot, wet, slippery, muddy, icy, dirty, cramped, etc... Work on and around moving machinery, vehicles and equipment.

Duties will include maintaining equipment, apparatus and buildings; participating in daily drills, protecting life and property; performing fire inspections, public education and miscellaneous duties as assigned.

EMS Standards are as follows:

- Any felony conviction w/in 15 years involving: intent to cause death or serious impairment, cruelty/torture, abuse/neglect/use of a firearm or dangerous weapon, diversion or adulteration of a prescription drug or other medications.
- Any felony conviction or attempt or conspiracy to commit a felony w/in 10 years
- Any conviction of criminal offenses w/in 15 years involving: Criminal sexual conduct in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th degree, Assault w/intent to commit criminal sexual conduct.
- Misdemeanor w/in 10 years involving: Firearms or dangerous weapons w/intent to injure, cruelty/torture, abuse/neglect, home invasion, embezzlement, negligent homicide, larceny, retail fraud (2nd deg), any other misdemeanor that involves assault, fraud, theft or possession of controlled substance.
- Misdemeanor w/in 5 years involving: assault w/no firearm or dangerous weapon, 3rd deg retail fraud, brandishing a firearm, cruelty by individual less than 16 years of age
